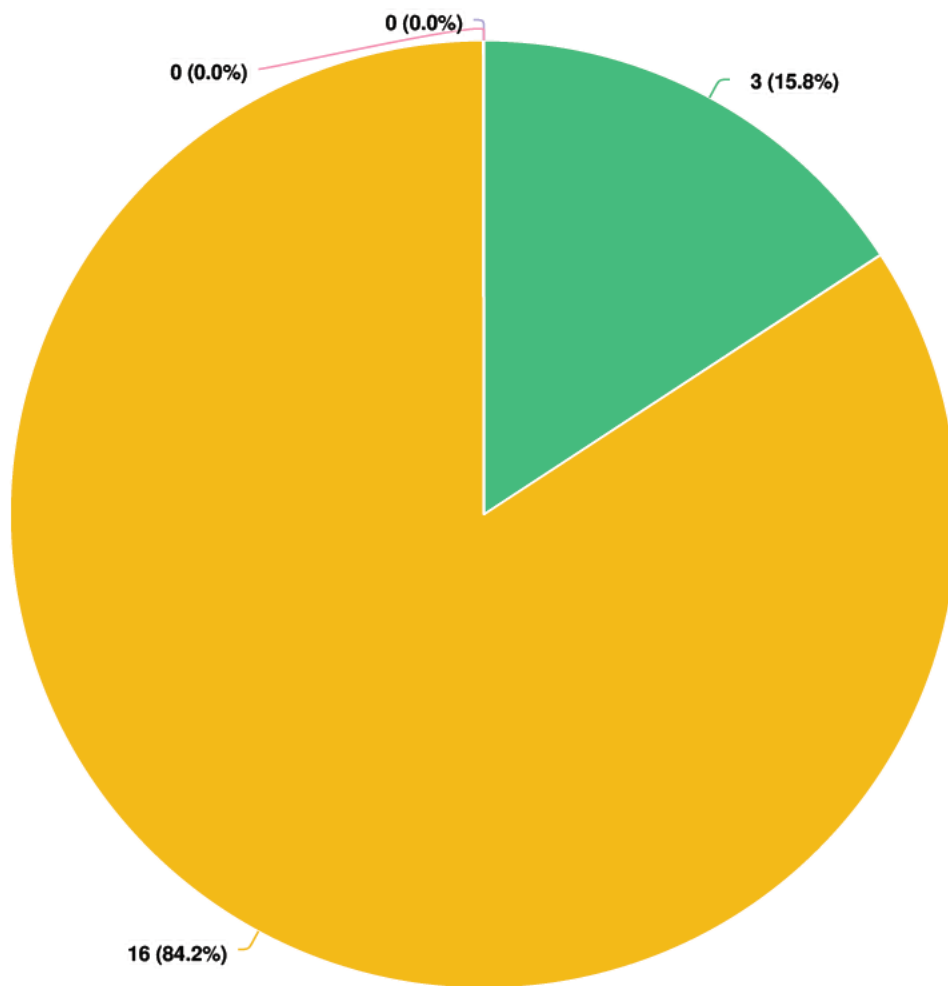

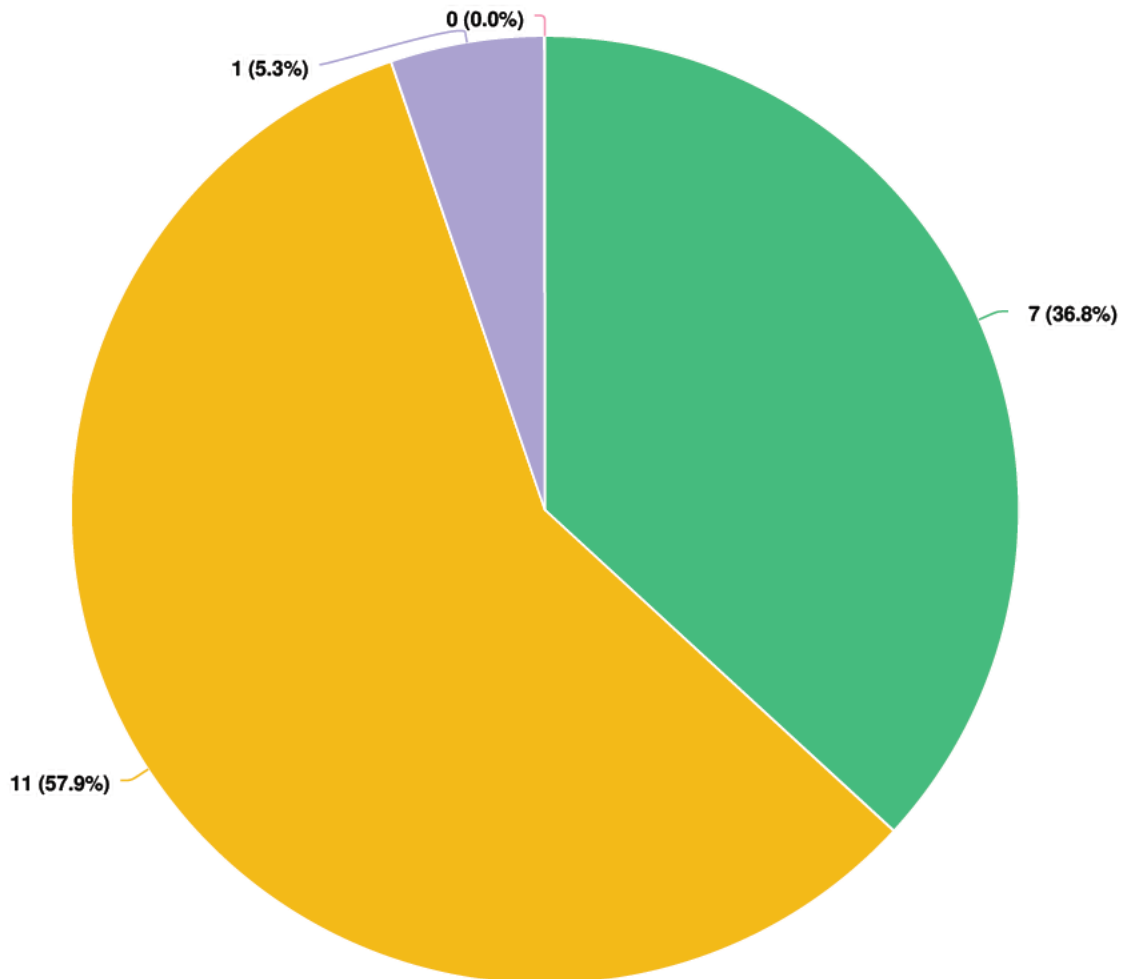

Q5 | Where would you prefer to live if it was affordable?



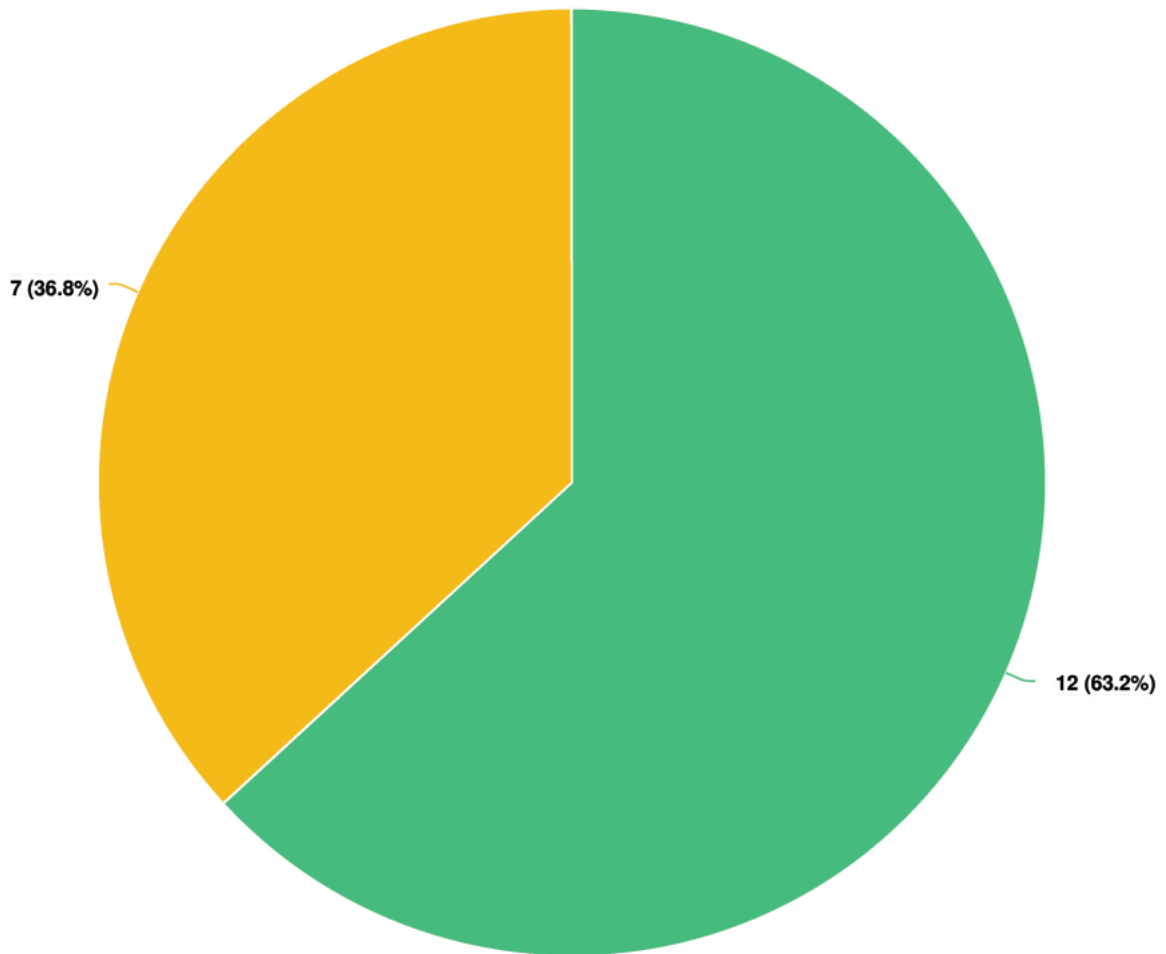

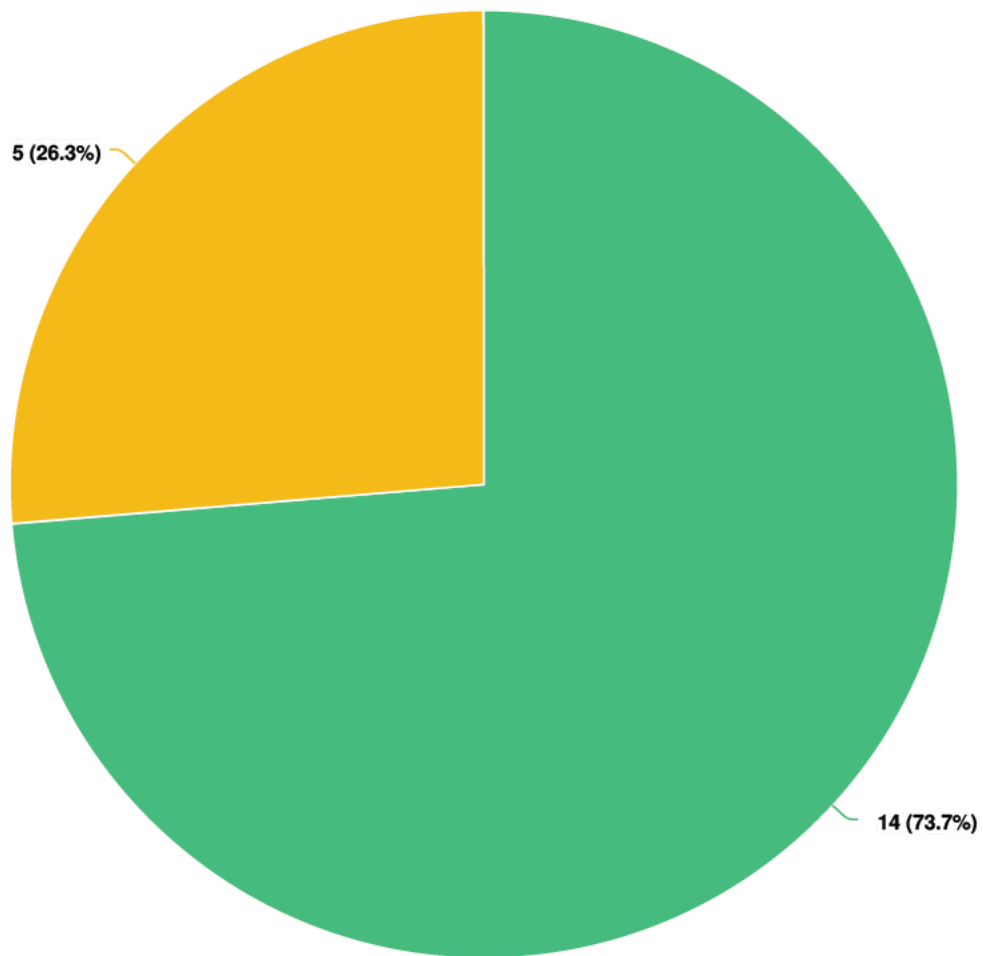
