SEWER CHARGE.

AS YOU WOULD UNDERSTAND THE HALL HAS
BEEN PLACED IN A POSITION BY COVID19 WHERE
VERY LITTLE INCOME IS BEING GENERATED.
WE HAD OUR LAST MARKET IN MARCH
BEFORE SHUTDOWN, RE OPENING FOR A MARKET
IN OCTOBER. OUR OP SHOP IN SEPARATE
PREMISES CLOSED IN MARCH, REOPENING PART TIME
IN JULY. THE RSL WANTED 3 MONTHS RENT
SINCE JULY A LOCAL CRAFT GROUP OF 4-6 LADIES
USE THE HALL ONCE A WEEK FOR 4 HOURS & AN
EXERCISE GROUP HAS RECENTLY ^{USING} RESTARTED THE HALL
ONCE A WEEK FOR APPROX 1 HOUR.

SO, OUR INCOME HAS BEEN EXTREMELY LOW. WE STILL
HAVE HAD TO OUTLAY ELECTRICITY, WATER, INSURANCE, MAINTENANCE &
THE WWCC SEWER CHARGE. WATER PAID WAS \$150.12 IN
FEBRUARY, \$53.76 MAY, \$45 SEPT \$45 NOV.

ALTHOUGH THE HALL HAS HAD VERY LITTLE USE WE HAVE
STILL HAD TO PAY THE SEWER CHARGE MAY \$137.00
SEPT \$131 NOV \$140.00. WE ASK IF IT WOULD BE
POSSIBLE FOR THE COUNCIL TO WAIVE ONE OR SEVERAL
PAYMENTS DUE TO NO OR VERY LOW USE OF TOILETS

AND OUR VERY DEPLETED INCOME WITH
NO FUNCTIONS BEING HELD, NO OF SHOP SALES
FOR 4 MONTHS.
