Hi Warren,

Just confirming a few things from yesterday's meeting with the Railway way team. Just so you have a rough cost guide.

The railway team will be in charge of the installation for the fence and our preference is for a 50/50 contribution from both council and the railway team. The railway team preference is for 100% council contribution.

I have taken some measurements for this fence line which also incorporates a two rock high retaining wall along the embankment.

• Fence line 110m. Fence I have had quoted is a mesh link 1.8m high with a top and bottom bar. And one single gate \$600.00.

I have a cost of \$54.00 per metre totalling \$5940.00 from absolute mesh.

 Two Rock high retaining wall (landscape rock 500mm – 800mm). My estimate is it will require to be 40m long.

Costs you are looking at is roughly \$800.00 for 10T. I believe you will require 40T - 50T. Totalling \$3200.00 - \$4000.00

Seeing as the railway team would be leading the project they would need to source contractors to complete this work. Contractors costs I believe you would be looking at are

- Excavation works at roughly \$110.00 hr.
- Fencing contractor roughly \$100 an hr.

These rough costs don't have contractor add-on costs either.

I feel the total project costs could be between 30k and 40k. The other challenge is also getting contractors available and getting fencing supplies. Steel prices are going up every month and when we have sourced fencing supplies it has taken weeks and months to get the stock.
