

# Lake Albert Precinct – Future Use and Development Map

The Lake Albert Precinct is a popular destination. This map identifies infrastructure additions and permitted activities to enhance the precinct as a key destination capitalising on the Active Travel Routes and the Wiradjuri Trail.

## 1 Accessible Shared Pathways:

- Widen to 3 metres and seal
- Spaced seating and water refill stations
- Develop connections from carparking lay-by locations.

## 2 Foreshores:

- Restoration of eroded areas
- Ongoing removal of encroaching vegetation due to low water levels
- Provision of Accessible Pier and Fishing Platforms.

## 3 Key Entertainment Nodes (Ron Wheeler/Bosley/Apex and Ray Beddoe Parks:

- Hard stands
- Formal access and car parking
- Increased seating/tables/shelters
- Event power supply and increased lighting
- Three-bin waste management system
- Temporary/Event food licensing.

## 4 Apex Park:

- Permit Commercial Operations e.g. Containerised Hospitality/Aquatic Recreation Hire
- Explore options for future use of kiosk building
- Redevelop Public Hall/Public Amenities to incorporate Change Rooms, Adult Laydown Change Facility
- Construct Bike Facility, Stage Area, Basketball Court

## 5 Event Viewing Area:

- Event power supply and increased lighting
- Formal access.

## 6 O'Halloran Park

- Renew Dog Agility Park
- Increase seating
- Provision of Public Toilets
- Irrigation of green spaces.
